



ANTI-RAGGING COMMITTEE

As per the order of Supreme Court of India and subsequent Notification from University Grants Commission (UGC), ragging constitutes one or more of any intention by any student or group of students on:

- 1. Any act of Indiscipline, Teasing or Handling with Rudeness.
- 2. Any act that Prevents, Disrupts the Regular Academic Activity.
- 3. Any activity which is likely to cause Annoyance, hardship, Psychological Harm or creates Fear or Apprehension.
- 4. Any Act of Financial Extortion or Forceful Expenditure.
- 5. Any Act of Physical Abuse causing Assault, Harm or danger to Health.
- 6. Any Act of abuse by spoken words, emails, SMS or public insult etc.
- 7. Any Act of injury or infringement of the fundamental right to the human dignity.
- 8. Any Act of Wrongful Confinement, Kidnapping, molesting or committing unnatural offences, use of criminal forces, trespass or intimidation.
- 9. Any unlawful assembly or conspiracy to ragging. Punishment to those found guilty

Any student or group of students found guilty of ragging in the campus or even outside the campus shall be liable to one or more of the following punishments

- 1. Debarring from appearing in any sessional test / University Examination
- 2. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges
- 2 Withdrawing scholarships and other hanafits

4. Suspension from the college for a period of one month

OBJECTIVES OF ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE

To prohibit any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student, or indulging in rowdy or indiscipline activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student or asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student, with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student; and thereby, to eliminate ragging in all its forms from universities, deemed universities and other higher educational institutions in the country by prohibiting it under these Regulations, preventing its occurrence and punishing those who indulge in ragging as provided for in these Regulations and the appropriate law in force.

Anti-Ragging Committee will be the Supervisory and Advisory Committee in preserving a Culture of Ragging Free Environment in the college Campus. The Anti-Ragging Squad- office bearers will work under the Supervision of Anti Ragging Committee and to engage in the works of checking places like Hostels, Buses, Canteens, Classrooms and other places of student congregation. Anti-Ragging Committee will be involved in designing strategies and action plan for curbing the Menace of Ragging in the college by adopting array of activities.

The student council & committees' election was held at GITARATTAN INSTITUTE OF ADVANCED STUDIES & TRAINING on 4th September 2024. Class Representative (CR), Deputy CR along with Secretary and Deputy Secretary for Cultural, Assembly, Decoration & Photography, Social media, Grievance & Sexual harassment, Editorial & Designing committee for magazine, Bulletin board and Discipline committee were selected.

A day before the actual election, B.Ed. students actively gave their names as potential nominees for various posts. 
Conclusion

Mode Of Election

The student council election was held on September 4, 2024. Before the election, Neha Ma'am went to the classroom and asked for nominations to be made on the spot. She ensured the eligibility conditions of the candidates were met and then instructed the students to write the name of whom they thought deserving for the position. In the preliminary round, candidates who had filed nominations were asked to give a speech to present their case on why they should be elected for the posts they had stood for. This was followed by student voting. A total of 25 students filed nominations for the posts of secretary and deputy secretary for various committees. On the day of the election, the ballot papers were sealed by Neha Ma'am and issued to the students. After that, she asked the voters to cast their votes. To ensure a fair and transparent selection process for the Student Council, a free and fair election was conducted. The voting process was carried out unanimously, with strict adherence to all rules and regulations. The voters had to write only one candidate's name on the ballot paper. After all the voters present in the room had cast their votes, the election officer asked them to settle down quietly while the ballot boxes were sealed.

OUTCOME OF STUDENTS ELECTION

The students were excited to choose their leader and were interested in casting their votes to their favorite ones. Discipline and decorum was maintained throughout the voting process. POLICY OF GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL COMMITTEE

Grievance Policy No. GRC/GIAST/01

Dated 27th July' 2019

1. Purpose

The Grievance Redressal Committee is formed to ensure the strife free atmosphere in the institute by promoting cordial student to student and student to teacher relationship for keeping the healthy working atmosphere progressive and qualitative improvement to enrich the institutional activities in the institute.

2. The Structure of the Grievance Redressal Committee

This Grievance Redressal Committee shall comprise of four members (faculty) nominated by the Principal of the institute viz: one convener and three faculties as member. Grievance Redressal Committee also includes nominated student representatives through interview shall be constituted for every academic session.

3. The Responsibility of the Grievance Redressal Committee

This Committee shall be responsible to address the grievances of the students related to infrastructure, technical, library, academic and administration or any other matter pertaining to the welfare of the students.

4. Grievance Redressal Mechanism

- (a) On the day when the academic year starts, a **notice** shall be displayed on the **Notice Board** mentioning therein the existing Grievance Redressal Committee in the institute, its objectives, members of the Grievance Redressal Committee and the procedure for the students to register for Grievance Committee.
- (b) The procedure for registering Grievance by the students shall be announced by the members of the committee
 - (c) The Grievance Redressal Committee shall meet in the month of July just before the beginning of new semester and then twice a month to review the entire process of how the grievances of the students were addressed and the necessary measures were taken. The proceedings of the meeting shall be recorded and signed by all the members and shall be kept in the file.
 - (d) The grievances of the students must be solved within a week from the date of registration of the grievance.
 - (e) The grievances of the students pertaining to infrastructure, technical, library, administration, the personal grievances of the student, the personal grudges of students against any faculty of the Institute shall be dealt by the Grievance Redressal Committee or student can directly approach to the Class Teacher.

(C) Mechanism for Election

"Empowering talents for equitable leadership"

Student Council Election (2024 -25), Talent Show & committee election was organised on September 04, 2024 in Gittaratan Institute of Advanced Studies and Training to give students an opportunity to introduce themselves and showcase their hidden talents in the presence of Principal & faculty members. For selection of Student Council, free and fair election was conducted. Voting was held unanimously and all the rules and regulations were followed. Following the protocol, CR and Deputy CR along with first different committee members were selected.

With the completion of admission procedures and having got all 100 students, as per the announcement made well in advance before ten days, the general election was held on 04.09.2024, Wednesday from 9:00am onwards. for the academic year 2024-2025. The manner of election was like presidential election where every representative, is elected directly by casting vote by the students and winners for the post declared at a time after counting the votes, so that the losing candidate would not be deprived of other posts. Each candidate was given a chance to introduce herself before the students casted their votes. After completion of procedures, newly elected students took the Oath.

After that the General Secretary as well as Secretaries-in-charge of various committees like the **Grievance committee**, Eco-club etc were elected in the same way .Each Secretary of the Student Council works in coordination with the In/Charge Teacher Education.

Student Council Election is a medium to introduce the students of GIAST the basis of electoral process and democratic practices. our institute indulges itself in introducing the students to be a part of political process. Being a part of political practices not only encourages political consciousness but also evoke the importance of participation and fair competition. Our college hence makes it mandatory for the students to be a part of various councils like general secretary, deputy general secretary, Grievance Redressal Committee, Training & Placement Committee, cultural committee, sports committeem, assembly committee discipline committee, CCA committee and volunteer committee. The entire process takes place in the class under the watchful eyes of the teachers and staff. The democratic practice of voting is encouraged and various representatives are selected thereafter by the students. Under the guidance of our respected Principal Ma'am the selected student representatives are congratulated and briefed about their roles in their respective committees.


