- *After sending soft copy of your paper, you will receive acknowledgment via email.*
- *Referencing should be as per the latest APA style.*
- *The selected papers may be published in our journal as per the guidance of Editorial & Referee Board.*

- *The papers shortlisted by our referees may find a place in our journal "Gitarattan Journal of Education".*
