1. BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE

1.1 CONCEPT OF CUET

CUET stands for Central Universities Entrance Test. It will be a computerized entrance examination for admission to 45 central universities of India and some other universities adopting this test for admission purposes. The examination will be conducted by the National Testing Agency, NTA, in the first week of July, after the Class 12 term 2 board exams will be over.

1.2 WHO CAN APPEAR FOR CUET?

The Central Universities Entrance Test (CUET) will be conducted for the admissions to the aforesaid universities of India. Therefore, students who have appeared in class 12 exam will be eligible to appear for the entrance exam.

1.3 WHY CUET?

For the last many years, we have been seeing the trend of skyrocketing cut-offs at several central universities, including Delhi University for admissions to undergraduate courses. As per experts, this is because CBSE, CISCE and the different state boards in India all have different evaluation patterns, which makes it unfair for students applying to central universities with a wide diversity in evaluation patterns.

The National Webinar aims at exploring the views of Stakeholders about the present scenario of the admission process in Higher Education. In this regard, GIAST has taken a humble initiative to conduct a webinar in order to make Teacher Educators aware of their opinion about the CUET. - A separate covering page indicating the theme, sub-theme, title of the paper, Name of the author(s), Designation, Organizational address, Phone number, and E-mail address should be sent with the manuscript.
- After sending a soft copy of your paper, you will receive acknowledgment via email.
- Referencing should be as per the latest APA style.
- The selected papers may be published in our journal as per the guidance of the Editorial &Refree Board
