# BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE

National Education Policy 2020 has been the main topic of discussion on various educational forums during the past one year. Its recommendations for various educational sectors have been immensely extolled by students, teachers, educationists and many other stakeholders. Some of its salient recommendations pertain to pre-school, school, higher and professional educational levels. Some suggestions are with respect to structures of educational institutes and others are theme-related. The structural changes, under the implementation stage, are the pre-primary stage, primary, middle and secondary stages. Graduation – pass course will be of 3 years and the Hons. Degrees with 4 years have been recommended and are at the implementation stage. The B.Ed. degree will be of 4 years duration right after the secondary stage. Similarly, some other structural changes have been recommended for further higher and professional education.

The policy reiterated the weak quality of students at the various stages of education. It lamented the poor attainment of literacy and numeracy even at the later primary and middle stages. This foundational weakness lingers on and takes away the meaningfulness from one's life. The policy showed its concern for rigid domains of subjects at the beginning of class 11th and recommended to give freedom to students to cross rigid boundaries of the restricted choice of choosing the subjects. It also recommended that 50% of the students of 11th and 12th school stage would be opting vocational subjects. A few other recommendations, among others, are holistic learning by the students, experiential learning, etc.

It is easy to suggest improvements, but very difficult to implement them in the right spirit. In spite of the plan of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan and other measures taken from time to time, we find many children are still out of school and many of those who are in school are very poor in numeracy and literacy. Kothari Commission, way back in 1964 recommended that 50% of senior secondary students should be in the Vocational Stream. The same clause has been added in the NEP 2020 also. We have bitterly failed in accomplishing this objective. Shall we succeed in this area – there is a big challenge. Similarly, there are many other challenges which the present policy has put forth. Hence the organisation of this seminar – National Education Policy – 2020 – the Challenges Ahead. The participants will be deliberating on the likely destinations – challenges in their accomplishments and how to hit them successfully. With these objectives in mind the Theme of the seminar and the sub themes are:
